

Engage with Gethsemane Assignment

Assignment:

Engage directly with God concerning the elimination of accusation from your heart and mind.

Purpose of the assignment:

- To hear the voice of Jesus calling you by your own name into Himself, there, in Gethsemane.
- To see yourself entirely inside this Jesus who willfully agreed to carry you all the way through death and into life.
- To see all things out from the eyes of this One in whom alone you live.
- To walk in the confidence that Jesus is planted now in this earth as you.

General guidelines:

Place yourself before God and inside of God. Believe that what He speaks already applies fully to you – through the words, “**Let it be to me according to Your word.**” Having asked, now believe that it already is.

You will not be sharing anything of this experience with God as a class assignment. However, free to share in the fellowship forum concerning anything specific God made real in you as a result of this exercise.

Specific directions for this assignment:

1. Begin your engagement with God by placing yourself through praise and thanksgiving into the knowledge of the Father arising always from within you.
2. Pray this prayer to the Father arising in your own heart. If you are able, pray it out loud.

“Father, You say in Your word that I was inside of Jesus as He walked through death and into life. Father, You say that Jesus willingly drank the cup that You asked Him to drink. Father, I ask You to show me, to cause me to hear the precious Lord Jesus calling my name, calling me into Himself, as He rose to His feet in Gethsemane. Father, Jesus said I was there, He said, ‘Here am I and the children You have given Me’; I know that You gave me to Jesus; I know I was there.

“My Father, I hear my name – I hear Jesus calling my name. I run into Him, for I would not be found anywhere else. Jesus drank me into Himself, all that I am, including all my awfulness. And here I am, Father, inside of Jesus, looking out through His eyes alone. Father, cause me to see only what Jesus sees, cause me to see all things through Him.

“Father, cause me to KNOW this Jesus in whom I am. As I stumble with Him when He stumbles, as I bleed with Him when He bleeds, as I weep with Him when He weeps, as I

laugh with Him when He laughs, cause me to know this Jesus, cause me to know Him as me.

“Father, I see the cross, I hear the words coming out of my own mouth, out of Jesus’ mouth, “It is finished.” I am part of Your victory. I am risen from the dead. I am ascended above the heavens. I am seated at Your right hand in all glory. Oh Father, what wonders I now know inside this Jesus where You have placed me forever.

“And Father, having asked these things in Jesus’ name, I now believe that I have received them. I believe, Father, and will confess, that I am utterly inside of Jesus including ALL of my sin and my shame. He has swallowed them up and they are no more. I believe and will confess that I am risen from the dead, that I am alive forevermore.

“Father, I see the cross, protecting me, keeping me utterly free to know this Jesus in whom I live. Father, I am IN Jesus. I am IN Jesus. I am IN Jesus. Never again will I see myself anywhere else.

“Lord Jesus, it is You. It is You who wanted me. It is You who called my name. It is You who drank me into Yourself. It is You who wants to spend all the ages to come together with me. You willingly and willfully chose me. You made me a part of You. Lord Jesus, I live inside Your heart forever, and You live in glory inside of mine. Lord Jesus, we share heart together.

“And now, Lord Jesus, as we look out through Your eyes, we see all those who also belong to You. You also drank them into Yourself, though they do not know it. From here on out, Lord Jesus, all that You and I go through utterly together, we endure all things for their sake. The Father is in us together, reconciling the world to Himself through every circumstance of our life.

Lord Jesus, to know that I am utterly with You and You with me, in me, as me, through me, and I through You, to know that this is forever – what joy we share, what unstoppable glory! Lord Jesus, I am in You and You are in me. You made it so. You love me and I love You – forever.”

3. Now, read/listen through the three lessons in this session on Gethsemane a second time (and even a third) inside the prayer you just prayed.
4. Give God thanks that He has already accomplished all that He speaks and that you are braided together with Him until the moment when the cover is removed from your eyes and you see for real that all that God speaks has already been true all along.
5. Make this the action of Jesus in Gethsemane, calling you into Himself by name, carrying you now all the way through death and into life, as the definition of your life, of all you think and say and do. Make this seeing out from Jesus’ eyes alone the rule over how you hear and see every word in the Bible.
