The Seventh Most Important Verse in the Bible

Hebrews 4:6/14 & 2 Corinthians 2:14

New King James Version (With one word changed from the NKJ, the second "confidence" to "assurance." Recommended for memorization).

Christ as a Son over His own house, whose house we are if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end. – For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our assurance steadfast to the end. – Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.

Amplified Bible

But Christ (the Messiah) was faithful over His [own Father's] house as a Son [and Master of it]. And it is we who are [now members] of this house, if we hold fast and firm to the end our joyful and exultant confidence and sense of triumph in our hope [in Christ]. – For we have become fellows with Christ (the Messiah) and share in all He has for us, if only we hold our first newborn confidence and original assured expectation [in virtue of which we are believers] firm and unshaken to the end. – But thanks be to God, Who in Christ always leads us in triumph [as trophies of Christ's victory] and through us spreads and makes evident the fragrance of the knowledge of God everywhere,

[Note: Every Bible definer wants to claim that we are NOT up there in God's chariot inside of Jesus as the Victorious Conqueror, but rather, that we are walking back in the line somewhere. Some want to place us as soldiers behind Jesus; others even want to take us back to the defeated foes way back in Jesus' train, far away from Him. The hostility towards our being utterly inside of Jesus is more evident in regards to this word "Triumph" than any seen yet.]

The Speaking of Christ (paraphrase by Daniel Yordy - written before doing the present study.)

I declare with all confident boasting that I am just like Jesus before God right now. I partake of all that is Christ as I keep my confidence high all the way through. I ask all that God speaks to be fulfilled in fullness in me, and I know that I have already received ALL that I ask. I give thanks for all things, expecting God always to arise in me, carrying me on high. I exult boastfully in the full and final victory of Christ in me, though I see it not and though I remain forever in the perfect weakness God made me to be. God ALWAYS leads me in triumph. I always speak Christ my life in all things.

The Speaking of Christ (paraphrase by Daniel Yordy – written AFTER doing the present study.)

We are Christ's dwelling place, we are become part of Christ IF INDEED – the confidence of speaking Christ our only life freely, the boasting and exulting that we are filled with Christ, that we are just like Jesus before God right now, the source of our substance and assurance, all the good things of Christ inside of us – IF INDEED these things unto the end upon firmness, upon absolute certainty, we should hold. Here is that certainty upon which we stand – God, the King of the universe ALWAYS, at all times, in every moment, through all things, ALWAYS leads us in the mighty celebration of a victory already won, foes already defeated, AS IF we were the ones who won the Victory, entirely inside of Christ Jesus, our Salvation and our only life AND this same God ALWAYS diffuses, sends forth in waves of awareness, the knowledge of God in every place we are and to everyone we meet.

Extension Verses

(New King James first – recommended for memorization. Then followed by my own rendition of meaning.)

Hebrews 10:23

Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

- Let's keep on speaking with all confidence and without wavering that we are just like Jesus before God right now, for God who speaks Christ makes all that He speaks personal and real inside of us.

Philemon 1:6

That the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.

- Your faith becomes affective as you acknowledge, as you speak, as you proclaim, every good thing, every good word that is inside of you, spoken into you by Christ Jesus, fulfilled in you by Christ Jesus as you, as you remain always inside of Christ Jesus.

Mark 11:24

Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.

– ASK! And whatever you ask God for, according to His Word, then believe that you have already received everything for which you have asked – and all things that you ask are yours in fullness now.

Luke 1:38

Then Mary said, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word."

– Look at me, God. I belong to You. Let every word that you speak be fulfilled in all fullness as the Lord Jesus Christ inside of me, as the only life I am.

Ephesians 5:20 & 1 Thessalonians 5:18

Giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. – In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

James 1:2-3

My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.

- Count it all joy, get excited and happy when all kinds of weird and unusual difficulties assail you, knowing that the Father and you together carry all things through every circumstance of your life.
